For the 2023-2024 school year, 50%+1 of the kindergarten through second grade students at West Park Elementary will be proficient on the May iStation Math Assessment and/or the percent proficient will increase by 10% from fall to spring.

For the 2023-2024 school year, 50%+1 of the kindergarten through second grade students at West Park Elementary will be proficient on the May ISIP and/or the percent proficient increase by 10% from fall to spring.

Every student at West Park will be assessed using formative assessments specific to reading learning targets being taught in the classroom. These assessments will be given for each learning outcome. Teachers will use this assessment data to determine placement for intervention to best meet individual student needs.
